Description of the project/artwork:

Bin is a proposal about bringing the idea of recycling and to raise environmental awareness and increase recycling efforts there needs to be quality and easily for people to get involved. This is what prompted us to begin our project to explaining the recycling program (plastic waste) and workshop in the kampung, school, etc focusing on community engagement. Therefore, in this project we are highlighting plastic waste which is widely use in this country. According to Statista (The Wall Street Journal) that Malaysia is a significant source of plastic waste in our oceans, contributing three times more mismanaged plastic waste than the United States, despite being only a tenth of the size of the US in terms of population. In addition, as reported by the WWF that China, Indonesia, Malaysia, the Philippines, Thailand and Vietnam which contribute 60% of the estimated 8 million tonnes of plastic that enter the world's oceans each year. It focused on household consumption of plastic packaging - the plastic most likely to end up in seas - and found that 27 million tonnes were consumed across all six nations in 2016, the most recent year for which reliable data was available. Globally the volume of plastic waste going into the ocean is set to quadruple between 2010 and 2050, meaning that the sea could contain more plastic by weight than fish by mid-century, the report noted.

Thus, it's become national problem that need to be solve now. We are proposing that, the plastic waste, it can reuse to produce an art object.
